General Bequests

I give, devise, and bequeath _____ (dollar amount, percentage of estate, or specific asset) to the Fayette County Community Foundation, a West Virginia nonprofit corporation and public charity, Tax ID 93-1351145, to be used for its charitable purposes.

Specific Bequests

When a particular item or property is bequeathed for a designated purpose, it is a specific bequest. For example, choosing a specific amount to a specific fund - \$1000 to the Foundation's Community Spaces fund.

I give, devise and bequeath to the Fayette County Community Foundation, a non-profit 501(c)(3) corporation, headquartered in Oak Hill, WV, the rest, residue and remainder (or state all, a \$ amount, or a percentage) to be used for its general support (or for the support of a specific school, unit, fund or program).

Residuary Bequests

This type of bequest is made when you intend to leave the residue portion of your assets after other terms of the will or trust have been satisfied.

Contingency Bequests

These bequests allow you to leave a portion of your estate to the Fayette County Community Foundation if your named beneficiary does not survive you.
